PROPANE PREP CHECKLIST



Your Essential Steps to Stay Warm and Worry-Free All Season



Check Your Propane Tank Level

Monitor your tank regularly. If you're a customer using our Will Call service, place your order when your propane levels reach 30% or at least 7 days before you anticipate needing a fill to avoid delays during peak delivery times.



Clear Snow and Ice Around Your Tank

Use a broom — not a shovel — to remove buildup from your tank, valves, and regulators. If you have an underground tank, mark its location with a flag or pole.



Create a Safe Path for Delivery Drivers

Clear a 10-foot-wide path on your road or driveway and around your tank by removing snow, ice, leaves, and fallen branches. This helps your delivery driver complete their route safely and efficiently.



Inspect and Maintain Your Propane Generator

Check fuel levels, replace filters, and perform general maintenance. Make sure your generator is ready in case of winter power outages.



Brush Up on Propane Safety Basics

Make sure everyone in your home knows what propane smells like and what to do if there's a suspected leak. Post emergency contact info in a visible location.



Conserve Propane When Possible

Set your thermostat to the lowest comfortable temperature and close off unused rooms. This can help extend your supply if your delivery is delayed by the weather.



Winterize Your Home

Seal cracks and drafts around windows, doors, and vents to keep warm air in and cold air out — saving energy and propane.



Inspect Your Heating System

Schedule a professional maintenance check to ensure your propane-powered furnace or boiler is operating at peak efficiency.



Store Portable Propane Cylinders Outside

Never bring propane cylinders indoors. Keep them upright, outdoors, and away from direct snow accumulation.



Sign Up for Auto Fill and Update Your Account Info

Ensure your Ferrellgas account is up to date with accurate appliance and tank details. Consider switching to Auto Fill to avoid running low unexpectedly.

If You Suspect a Gas Leak

Leave the Area Immediately

If you smell gas or suspect a leak, act immediately. Leave the area right away, ensuring that everyone else does the same. Once you are at a safe distance, call 911 and Ferrellgas at 866-708-8209. Our team will respond as quickly and safely as possible.

Avoid Creating Sparks

As you leave, avoid igniting the leaking gas. Some electrical devices and appliances can create sparks when manipulated.

- Do not turn any light switches on or off.
- Do not interact with any appliances, outlets, or phones.
- No smoking, vaping, or open flames.

Stay Away And Report The Leak

Once safely away, call your Ferrellgas team at 888-337-7355 or dial 911, or the fire department. Stay away from the suspected gas leak until your propane retailer, emergency responder, or qualified professional determines that it is safe to return. Turn off gas at the tank(s), unless you suspect there is a leak at the tank(s). To close the valve, turn it to the right. Before using any propane appliances again, have your entire propane system checked by your local Ferrellgas team to make sure there are no leaks.
